

SAIL CAMP 2008

PARENT INFORMATION

WHERE: The Palm Beach Sailing Club is located at 4600 North Flagler Drive on the beautiful **Intracoastal Waterway**. From I-95 take 45th Street East to North Flagler Drive. Turn left (North) on Flagler Drive — The club will be immediately on your right.

WHEN: Arrive 10 minutes early if possible so your child can begin setting up his or her boat. Check in with a staff member or instructor upon arrival. We want to maximize class time so the campers can get the most from their sailing experience. Please pick up your child promptly when the session ends. A.M. sessions start at 8:30 and end at 12:00 Noon and P.M. sessions start at 1:30 and end at 5:00. Full day sessions begin at 8:30 and end at 5:00.

WHAT TO BRING:

- ❑ A Coast Guard Approved Flotation Device (also known as a Life Jacket) that fits your child properly. West Marine, Wal-Mart or any boating store will sell these. Check the size and weight for a proper fit. Don't forget to put your child's name on the inside.
- ❑ **SUNSCREEN:** The Florida sun is brutal; a waterproof sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher is recommended. A hat and sunglasses help also.
- ❑ Water to drink (we provide the water to sail on). Dehydration will not be allowed. Two bottles of water per session should do it.
- ❑ Closed-toe water shoes. Old sneakers work well also. Your child may end up swimming in them. These shoes will get wet!
- ❑ A dry change of clothes and a towel.
- ❑ Your Parent Packet forms. Don't forget to fill out the End-Of-Camp Party RSVP Card and mail it to us.
- ❑ Sailing Gloves. (Not required but they help keep young hands young.) Salt water drenched sailboat lines can cause irritation.
- ❑ For those children taking advantage of our all-day session, please pack a lunch. There is refrigeration available in the boathouse.

ADDITIONAL SESSIONS: If you would like to sign up for additional sessions or want to take advantage of our all day option, please do so soon. Our camp sessions are filling up fast and we don't want to disappoint anyone.

END OF SUMMER BASH: Our End-of-Summer Bash will be on Friday evening, August 23rd, at 11:30 a.m. Please fill out the RSVP card given on the first day of camp so we can notify the caterer. You can drop it off at the club, mail it to us or call the reservation line at (561) 881-0809. We will have a 'Camper Awards Ceremony', a huge water slide, prizes, games, raffles and catered food. Prizes include a Palm Beach Sailing Club one-year membership and free 2008 Sailing Camp sessions along with other cool stuff. You don't want to miss this one.
